You can also benefit by visiting the Educator and Parents Zone with CPD opportunities, guidance on free tools and partners to support your delivery of careers education.

On the day, students can:

- Take part in an interactive employability workshop with Google
- Join the Live Zone discussions with insight in to **Sustainability**, **Al and Cyber Security**
- Be inspired by **young innovators** who have secured funding to bring their creations to market
- Sign up for project-led, **virtual work experience placements** to enhance employability
- Learn about the various **career pathways** available to make informed decisions about next steps after school
- Visit virtual booths from prospective universities, colleges or employers such as Hitachi ABB Power Grids, BT and more.

Students can register individually to take their own journey around the interactive platform. Although we are publicly promoting the event to individuals aged 16-24, the event has been designed to benefit students from 14+. Live Virtual NHS Healthcare Work Experience

Good afternoon

As you know some of your students are participating in our <u>Live Virtual NHS Work Experience for Allied Health Careers this includes:</u>

Nursing, Midwifery, Paramedicine, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Dietetics, Radiography, Prosthetics and orthotics, Speech and language therapy, Osteopathy, Pharmacy and Podiatry too!

We wanted to remind you the next work experience session date is on **Sunday 6th June**, please do remind all students taking part to register for the next session before Wednesday 3rd June. This programme is available to support all of your aspiring healthcare students as an alternative to inperson NHS work experience during the pandemic. Please inform your students who are interested in the NHS Allied Healthcare Professions.

During the work experience day, students will follow 2 patients from their initial presentation to recovery. Students will observe the healthcare professionals as they interact with the patients and also each other. Students will have an opportunity to ask questions and gain knowledge through teaching.

This will help students to make an informed career decision as well as learn about how healthcare professionals work together as part of a multidisciplinary team. Each work experience day is completely different and students will be able to build on their knowledge of NHS careers as they see different patient cases and their healthcare professionals work in a variety of settings, such as hospital and community.


