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From the Principal

I am delighted to inform you that the College has achieved an outstanding set of Teacher Assessed Grades due to the cancellation of examinations as a result of the pandemic which were still assessed with the new rigorous grading scale. All subjects are now be graded on a 9 to 1 scale, where 4 is described as a 'standard pass' and grade 5 is a 'strong pass'.

Like many schools we are calculating our exam statistics using existing benchmarks, where there are agreed equivalents.

The new grade 9 is a very challenging standard, above that of an A* and so we were extremely pleased that 15 students secured a grade 9 in Maths and that there was a total of 23 grade 9s in English Language and English Literature. There were 3 students who gained a grade 9 in Maths, English Language and English Literature along with 6 students who achieved grade 9s for all three of their Sciences. A quarter of our students achieved 5 or more top grades (9-7, A*/A) including English and Maths.

There are a number of important benchmarks listed below. Those that are in bold type are a personal best for Collingwood College in 2021!

- **79% or 243 students achieved 5 or more A*-C/4+ grades**
- **81% or 249 students achieved a 4+ grade in English and Maths**
- **58% or 178 students achieved a 5+ grade in English and Maths**
- **81% or 251 students achieved 5 or more A*-C/4+ grades including English and Maths**
- **25% or 78 students achieved 5 or more A*/A/7+ grades including English and Maths**
- **28% of all GCSE grades (2911 entries) were at A*/A or 7+**
- **23 students achieved 11 or more A*/A or 7+ grades**
- **84% achieved a 4+ grade in Maths**
- **86% achieved a 4+ in English Language or English Literature**
- 21% achieved a 4+ in 3 separate Sciences
- 76% achieved a 4+/4-4+ in at least two Sciences

Results for the Sixth Form continue to be outstanding for grades awarded at A*-B for A level or Distinction*/Distinction for BTEC. All the students who wanted a university place were successful. We are also very pleased to support more students to secure places on higher level apprenticeships, as these can be a very attractive alternative for many.

As parents/carers you will know this represents an incredible amount of hard work and commitment from our staff and students and we are all extremely proud of their achievements in this unprecedented year.

We are absolutely delighted with our ALPS (progress) score which is an 'outstanding 2' for **both** GCSE level and 'A' level TAGS. This means we are in the top 10% of schools nationally for 2021 which is a truly fantastic achievement!

The students who took exams at the end of Year 10 achieved a **97%** pass rate in their GCSE RS short course with **79%** of students gaining a 9-4 grade.

The students who took a one-year course in Year 9 were rewarded with excellent results too. As a consequence, more **than 80%** of the current Year 10 cohort already have a qualification graded 4 or better which bodes well for future examination success!

At Collingwood we are committed to developing responsible, aspirational, independent, happy and well-rounded young people but the curriculum must ensure that all students are able to follow a suitable range of courses so they can enjoy exam success. In 2021, **92%** of students achieved at least one 9-4 or equivalent grade and **35%** of students achieved at least one 9-8 or equivalent grade.

We are driven by our desire to ensure that students leave Collingwood with the appropriate qualifications to access their chosen career path and the personal skills to make a valuable contribution to society. Despite changes to performance league tables, we will continue to maintain a strong focus on maximising the number of students who can pass 5 good GCSE subjects, including English and Maths and 3 A level or BTEC subjects in the Sixth Form and allow students and parents to make the right choices regarding optional subjects.
