

# frequently asked QUESTIONS



**What equipment do I need to bring in on my first day in September?**

Pen, pencil, ruler, eraser, notebook, packed lunch (if you are not going to buy lunch). You do NOT need to bring in your PE kit.

**Where do I get on the bus to come to College and where do I get off?**

Your parent will have arranged where and what time you get your bus to come to College. All the buses, apart from public buses, stop outside Barossa. This is where you get off at the start of the day and on at the end of the day.

**Where do I go on my first day in September?**

You go straight to Kingston Theatre at 8.20am. You will then be taken to your Form room.

**Where do I get my ID card?**

Your Form Tutor will give you your ID card at the beginning of the first day.

**Can I still buy food if I don't have money on my ID card?**

NO. Your parent should put money on your card as soon as possible once they have been provided with their login and password. You can check how much money you have on your card by using the machine in Barossa reception.

**How do I know which lessons I have?**

Your Form Tutor will give you your timetable on your first day. This tells you which lessons you have on each day as well as the room to go to. They will also give you a planner which is used to record your home learning.

**I have an asthma inhaler and/OR an auto injector. Is it possible to leave a spare in College?**

YES. We would recommend that we hold a spare inhaler/auto injector in reception. Your parent will need to provide the medication in its original prescribed packaging and complete a form provided at Barossa reception.

**What about my locker key?**

If your parent has ordered and paid for a locker, you will be given your key during the first week of term.

**What happens at home time?**

The bell will go at 3.05pm. If your parent has said you can walk home, you can go straight home. If you are meeting your parent make sure you have arranged where to meet them. Parents cannot drive into the College car parks to pick you up. If you catch the bus, see the next question.

**Where do I go to get the bus home?**

Go to the area between the Barossa building and the Sixth Form Centre. Staff on duty will tell you which line to join for your bus. Listen out for your bus number to be called and then get on the bus.

**Where do I go on my second day in September?**

You go straight to your Form room when the bell rings on the second day and every other day after that. You must enter Barossa building via H, J or F block doors and not through the main entrance.
